Herts Youth Project: building skills in education and employment

What will I be doing in class?

You will be learning skills to prepare you for the world of work, this includes personal and interpersonal skills – getting you to work well alone and with others in a team. You will also gain a St John's Ambulance First Aid Certificate.

What will I get out of this?

This course can help you get back on track at school, find employment or routes into further education. You will build up an impressive CV of skills, gain leadership and communication skills as well as building your confidence, motivation and self awareness.

Is it all based in a classroom?

Primarily yes, but there are trips and team building projects planned.

How is this different to school?

You will be working in an adult environment, you do not have to wear a uniform, and the atmosphere is friendly and relaxed. You will be in small study groups giving you the attention and support you need. You will also learn effective skills to work alone and with other students.

Where is the course being taught?

How long is the course?

It is 10 weeks long and you will be expected to attend every Wednesday from 9.30am until 2.30pm, with a 30 minute lunch break.
