

The 16-19 Tuition Fund for the 2021 to 2022 academic year

The 16 to 19 tuition fund is ring-fenced for schools, colleges, and all other 16 to 19 providers, to mitigate the disruption to learning and all other forms of disadvantage arising from the Covid-19 pandemic.

The purpose of this statement is to set out how Barnfield College will utilise its 16 to 19 tuition fund.

Who can be supported by this fund?

Students aged 16-18 who have been disadvantaged by missed learning; who have not achieved grades 4 or 5 in English and/or Maths; who have been disadvantaged in other ways as a result of the Covid-19 pandemic; and students who have special educational needs and disabilities and aged 19-24.

How is Barnfield College using this fund?

Students will receive additional tuition in small groups and/or on a 1:1 basis to help them with English, Maths, vocational and other technical subjects. This tuition will be in addition to course and qualification timetabled hours and will be delivered face to face and on-line as appropriate.

Who will provide the additional tuition?

The College will deliver all additional tuition using teachers and support staff from its own workforce.

How can students access additional tuition?

The College will ensure all students complete assessments at the beginning of their courses and throughout the year, to identify the knowledge and skills they need to catch up. Additional tuition will be personalised to meet individual needs and regular reviews will take place to ensure students are making the necessary progress and attainment.
